Union Notes:

1. Policies are eligible to lapse two years after they are passed.
2. Policies are often forgotten about or unactioned if the parties involved leave or graduate.
3. Policies often make reference to positions and job roles which alter according to changes in the constitution.

Union Believes:

1. Policies should reflect the students' of UEA and through this the Union's attitude upon issues.

Union Resolves:

1. At the start of each year the policies of the Union of UEA Students are amended to reflect any changes in the terms of reference according to changes in the constitution. Any disparity regarding the amendments will be decided upon at the discretion of the Chair of Union Council and the Communications Officer.
2. At the start of every year the Student Officer Committee will submit a report regarding the current status of policies to Union Council to ensure no polices are overlooked. This report has the power to recommend policies to lapse early if no longer relevant or unactionable.
