Notes

- 1) That the Union of UEA students collects the details of students which it takes on protests.
- 2) That the police may request this information after protests, even if students have broken no law.
- 3) That we have no policy to guide SOC on what its response to police requests should be.

Believes

- 1) That students should be able to go on protests without fear that their personal information will be given to the police.
- 2) That for a union to be successful all its members must trust it with their personal information.
- 3) When Students give there information to the union they should know the information should go no further.

Resolves

- 1) To refuse to give student information to the police where doing so may result in prosecution of a student unless legally required.
