This Union notes:

1. Currently the funding for accommodation for away events is £8 per person per night.
2. Cost of accommodation has increased dramatically since this level of contribution has been set.
3. Events are an integral part of the functioning of competitive clubs and the financing should not prevent or hinder clubs participating in these events.

This Union believes:

- 1.The contribution of the union to clubs and societies should reflect national trends in pricing
- 2.£8 pppn. is too low a contribution to the cost of an event

This Union resolves:

- 1.To increase the contribution from £8 per person per night. to £10 per person per night, and thereafter in line with inflation (RPI).

Noted:	L Perkins, in favour, argued that one of the main roles of the Union was to support sports and part of the aims of its sports clubs was to compete nationally and raise the profile of UEA. In order to compete away, the Union supports members of clubs with £8 toward accommodation. The figure had stayed the same for a long time as costs have risen. She was asking for a sensible increase to £10.
Received:	An amendment, from the floor, that would increase the amount in line with inflation as measured by RPI, was accepted by the proposer.
